

CHURCHYARD NEWS: Now that the weather is improving we're continuing our plans to improve and maintain the churchyard as somewhere worthy of those laid to rest there. Please email Lynne Watson at safeguarding@stpetershersham.com if you are able to help with clearing and tidying of the Churchyard on Saturday afternoons 2pm to 4pm. Do come and have a look at what has been achieved so far, it looks great! It is also our intention to ensure graves are kept neat and tidy. Please consider signing up to Adopt a Grave: weeding a specific grave or a number of graves in a designated area so that as a community, we can respect and preserve the dignity of those who established the village as we know it today. Our very grateful thanks are extended to Woodlark Nurseries Ltd for again donating all the beautiful pots of daffodils which we are going to plant around the churchyard.

ST. PETER'S CHURCH ELECTORAL ROLL: Being on our Church Electoral Roll is a way of demonstrating your willingness to help shape the future of the Church, not just locally, but nationally. It also enables you to participate and vote in the Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM) which will be held in church after the 10.30am service on Sunday 19th May. If you would like to have your name entered on the roll, you need to fill in a form no later than 4 May. Please take a form from the back of church (noting you must be baptised, over 16 and have attended worship at St. Peter's for at least six months prior to enrolment), fill it in and return it to Sarah by putting it in the Parish Office pigeon hole in church. The current list is on the back table: if you're already on it you don't need to fill in another form.
